### **INTRODUCTION**

Gyankunj International School, Khargone organised a Cyber Crime and POCSO Awareness Programme for the students of Classes VII to XI on 24 August 2026. The objective of the programme was to create awareness among students about cyber crimes, online safety, responsible use of digital technology, child protection and the legal provisions designed to safeguard children. The session provided students with practical guidance on staying safe, alert and responsible both online and offline.

### **PROGRAMME PROCEEDINGS**

The programme commenced with the arrival and seating of the distinguished guests. The guests were warmly welcomed by the school fraternity. The programme began with Goddess Saraswati Pujan, seeking blessings for knowledge and wisdom. The distinguished guests were then welcomed with bouquets as a token of respect and gratitude.

The guests were formally introduced by Ms. Gauri Solanki, who welcomed the dignitaries and briefly introduced their professional roles and contribution towards legal awareness and student sensitisation. Following the introduction, the microphone was handed over to the esteemed guests for the awareness session.

### **CYBER CRIME AWARENESS SESSION**

The speakers explained the growing importance of cyber safety in the lives of students and discussed various forms of cyber crime and online risks. Students were sensitised about online frauds and scams, phishing and suspicious links, fake accounts and online identities, safe use of social media, protection of passwords and personal information, privacy and digital footprints, cyberbullying, safe use of mobile phones and digital devices, risks associated with sharing photographs and personal information, responsible use of the internet and the importance of reporting suspicious online activities.

Students were advised to remain cautious while interacting with unknown persons online and to seek help from parents, teachers or other trusted adults whenever they encounter an unsafe or uncomfortable situation.

## **POCSO AWARENESS SESSION**

A detailed awareness session was also conducted on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act. The speakers explained the importance of child protection and sensitised students about personal safety, appropriate and inappropriate behaviour, personal boundaries and the importance of speaking up when they feel unsafe.

The session covered the purpose and importance of the POCSO Act, protection of children from sexual offences, understanding personal boundaries, recognising safe and unsafe behaviour, recognising uncomfortable situations, the importance of saying no to inappropriate behaviour, speaking to a trusted adult, reporting inappropriate behaviour, online safety and protection from inappropriate online interactions, and responsible use of social media.

Students were encouraged to understand their rights and were advised that they should never feel ashamed or afraid to seek help if they experience or witness inappropriate behavior. The session also emphasised that child safety is a shared responsibility of students, parents, teachers, school authorities and society.

## **STUDENT PARTICIPATION**

Students of Classes VII to XI attended the programme with keen interest. The session was interactive, and students listened attentively to the explanations and practical examples shared by the speakers. Students were given an opportunity to ask questions and clarify their doubts regarding cyber safety, child protection and legal awareness.

## **KEY LEARNING OUTCOMES**

The programme helped students to:

- Understand common forms of cyber crime and online fraud.
- Develop safe and responsible digital habits.
- Protect personal information, passwords and privacy.
- Recognize potential online risks and unsafe interactions.
- Understand the basic purpose of the POCSO Act.
- Recognize the importance of personal boundaries and child safety.
- Speak up and seek help when they feel unsafe.
- Understand the importance of reporting inappropriate or harmful behavior.
- Become responsible and aware digital citizens.
